SYSTEM COMPONENTS



Masimo Chip

- Reusable chip snaps into the sensor and communicates with the Home Medical Hub.



Masimo Halo App

- Displays monitoring status.
- Cloud sends alerts to Home Medical Hub and mobile device.
- Compatible with most mobile devices. (Mobile device not included.)



Home Medical Hub

- Collects data from Masimo Sensor.
- Sends data to smartphone app.
- Store the chip in the holder on top of Home Medical Hub.

Masimo Sensor

- Disposable sensor provides the monitoring data and lasts up to 96 hours in typical continuous usage.
- Sensor may be removed when not in use. Be sure to remove chip between use to preserve battery life.

SET UP APP & CONNECT HOME MEDICAL HUB

1. Download the app and create an account.

SET UP SENSOR

1. Remove sensor from pouch.





3. Place sensor on wrist as shown and carefully thread the tip of the strap through



 Wrap the loose end of the strap around your wrist and press to secure.
